### **Gold medal for Kaimira Estate ITI Selection Riesling 2010 at Royal Easter Show**

Premium Nelson producer Kaimira Estate has won a gold medal for its 2010 ITI Selection Riesling at the Royal Easter Show Wine Awards. It is believed that it is the only Nelson winery to have won such a high award for a low alcohol Riesling.

Ian Miller, Director of Kaimira Estate said: “This result is a real thrill as this is our first ever release of a low-alcohol wine and it is a tribute to the efforts of our entire team.”

In addition to being lower in alcohol, the 2010 Iti Riesling is made from grapes grown under organic conversion and is fully accredited under the carboNZero C<sup>ert</sup>™ programme.

“Iti” is Maori for “small” and the team at Kaimira Estate has opted to name their new wine style accordingly to signify that the wine has been crafted to be naturally lower in alcohol. The wine was made with lunch time and aperitif occasions in mind.

The winery also picked up a silver medal for its 2010 Brightside Nelson Pinot Gris, and bronze medals for the 2010 Kaimira Estate Brightwater Gewurztraminer and the 2010 Kaimira Estate Brightwater dry Riesling, all grown at its estate vineyards in Brightwater.
